How can you learn from such a person as I am? I can agree with you that I have sinned and I endure the most intense pain due my sin. And all I can talk of is a child who should be able to see sunshine beaming from a blue sky. I can cry and mourn before the world in her name and who shall listen and why should I care to be heard? "For nothing now can come to any good."

## **GUILT/REMORSE**

Q: Do you constantly feel guilty that you are not being punished even though you are responsible for her death?

A: There is not a day that goes by that I do not experience the most intense feelings of guilt for what

I did to my precious little friend. As I have said, no punishment would suffice - not prison nor

death. My life isn't worth what her life was worth. The guilt consumes me.

Q: How do you mentally handle it today, aside from Brooke's support? Are you seeing a professional therapist?

A: My loss of JonBenét is most difficult to handle in so many ways. I am fortunate that I can visit

JonBenét's grave as well as her mother. It means the world to me to be close to her there. I have

done so much crying over the years. I will not let myself forget nor will I forgive myself for what I

did to this wonderful child. And yes, Brooke is always there for me no matter what I am going

through. No, I am not seeing a therapist.

Q: JonBenét was a gorgeous, bright, innocent little girl. She just wanted to have fun and live

life at its fullest! John why would you take that away from her? Why did you kill her, if you

did? If you loved her so much, why would you kill her?

A: Thank you for those kind words about JonBenét. She was a wonderful little girl. I grieve for her

every day. I most certainly loved her. Words cannot describe the guilt I feel for taking the precious

life of the most wonderful child I have ever known. And for that, I am not worthy to live.

## **CONFESSION/EVIDENCE/JUSTICE**

Q: If you really do care for JonBenét and her family, why did you let the Boulder police and

the media drag their names through the dirt? Why did you wait nearly ten years to confess?

A: I am sorry for not coming forth earlier. I owe nothing to law enforcement. My allegiance is to

JonBenét and to her family. I reached out to her dying mommy and made every effort to grant

her peace.

Q: If you love JonBenét as you say you do, then don't you think she deserves justice?

Don't

you think you owe her that much for taking her life, whether it was an accident or not?

A: Justice comes in many forms.

Q: I have seen you state before that "yes you were involved in JonBenét's death". Would you consider that incriminating evidence in itself? I'm not sure why you would make that comment that you were involved in the death but will decline to answer other questions because you might incriminate yourself.

A: At this point, I have been released. Providing new information is something I cannot do. Presenting new evidence is something I cannot do. The information I provided last year resulted in my arrest. The information was powerful. I must not expound on that information.

### **Statements:**

There is more than meets the eye concerning the DNA evidence. I am not free due the DNA that was found. I am free due the DNA that was not found.

I am not free due the DNA that was found. I am free due the DNA that was not found. To find more out about the significance or lack thereof of the DNA evidence, I would ask you to read or listen to anything that Dr. Henry Lee has said about the DNA in this case.

I discussed the reasons why my DNA was not found in the most obvious places with my DNA attorney. Her mouth would be the most obvious place yet it was explained to me that the removal of the tape disrupted the finding of DNA there. I also asked about DNA evidence inside her mouth which would have occurred during a revival attempt to which he said that this was not a guarantee that DNA evidence would be left behind there. I asked if DNA could be left by dry kisses about the body to which he responded that, unless there was a transfer of saliva or a bleeding abrasion on my lips, there was no guarantee that DNA would be left behind. There is more but this is what I am sharing now.

The DA had stated I had led them to the DNA found by something I said which I only found out about in my interview with Dan Abrams on August 16, 2007 when the news reel was shown. I was amazed at this new finding knowing full well that I did not say what she said led them to that DNA. Her comment in full can be found on the link I provided to the interview in the category on my website entitled "Media".

This DNA is simply not pertinent.'

In 2001, I left America for the sole purpose of evading law enforcement. That should be held into account now.

If I do turn myself in, it will be to law enforcement and not to a forum conducted on the Internet - whether my own forum or someone else's forum. If I turn over evidence I possess, it will not have anything to do with proving myself to you or anyone else.

I provided thorough information during the time that I was in communication with Michael Tracey. I reached out to Patricia before she passed away making every effort to grant peace and understanding to her. I did not resist arrest nor did I deny my involvement. There was enough evidence against me to merit an arrest warrant and extradition from Asia to America. There are many ways one pays for one's sins that might not be conventional. As far as the information I provided that directly lead to my arrest, this has not been published, does not reside in the public domain and it was information that could only be verified by JonBenét's parents. As far as I know to date, the information I provided has not been disclosed to the public.

I will never reveal the location of the evidence I must forever withhold. If you are speaking of the information that was never made public, I also will not reveal that. There was the matter of a supposed alibi presented by my ex-wife; however, I must quote what she said: Referring to Lacy conference quotes:

"The wife and he were to a great degree estranged at the time. So the former wife who we find to be very credible and very helpful and very co-operative . She did everything she could to dig up every document, photo she could find and she interviewed with officers for some 10-12 hours was unable to establish and when actually asked, "Can you state he was with you?", she had to say "No, I can't". "That's not my best recollection" is what she said, "but I cannot state that"."

The urgency of confessing at the time that I did was due the fact that Patricia was dying. I made every effort to reach out to her. I pray that she experienced peace and understanding. I know that I owed her so very much. I tried so hard to give her a sense of closure as best I could at the time. I was thousands of miles from her and did my best to reach her and comfort her. My deepest regret is that I did not go to her side at the end and speak to her of JonBenét face to face. After Patricia passed away, I continued to talk to John prior to my arrest. I know how very much I owe her parents and their wonderful child. It is a debt that can never be paid through any action. Life in prison is not enough. Death is not enough. Nothing can suffice.

Please keep in mind that I did not have an attorney in Thailand. My cooperation with authorities exceeded what it should have without a lawyer present.

I never said I picked her up after school, nor did I say I drugged her, nor did I say I had sexual intercourse with her. That never came out of my mouth. The Thai authorities misquoted me on three statements due their lack of speaking fluent English. The one detective who spoke English told me that he passed on conversations he had with me to his superiors who interpreted them the way they wanted. These superiors obviously did not speak English well. When I found out that the statements were being aired, I asked the detective to confirm all three of them by asking him the following:

Karr: Did I say that I picked JonBenét up after school on Christmas Day?

Thai Detective Superchai: No.

Karr: You know I am a teacher and was a father and know full well that children don't go to school on Christmas Day.

Karr: Did I say I had sexual intercourse with JonBenét?

Thai Detective Superchai: No.

Karr: Did I say I drugged JonBenét?

Thai Detective Superchai: No

Karr: The media says that the authorities have said that I have made those three statements and you are the only Thai authority I am talking to. Will you please go before the press and confirm that I did not make those three statements?

Thai Detective Superchai: I will do that for you. I report my conversations to my superiors and they interpret them as they wish.

And so, Thai Detective Superchai went down before the media and refuted all those statements. However, I do not think the press reported that hardly at all as important as it was. Those statements that I did not make hurt my credibility and the case. My accounts were already recorded and written. I never mentioned any of those statements in any writings or recordings prior to my arrest nor did I ever say those things after my arrest.  
Statements:

I know not the plans of God regarding any remote possibility of Paradise for me.

I am trying my best. I do feel remorse untold for what I have done.

I have never claimed to be anything but a sinner...

...I never claimed to be a good Christian. I have said I try to subscribe to the teachings of Christianity. I have been the worse sinner on earth. ...

... I continue to stand by what I said last year while the world spits upon me. While you think that the only justice is to turn myself in, I have already faced law enforcement who let me go. Have you been there with me while I faced that? Have you been there for all these years that I have tortured myself for my actions on that night? You are swift to judge. You know so little of my suffering - yes suffering I deserve. And the death that I will ultimately face, I so deserve. But I will do it in my own way and in my own time. And if I am not to pay as you deem necessary, find comfort that I will suffer eternally after my death.

I deserve no forgiveness. I have never asked for it.

I confessed. And in that I have taken responsibility for my sin regardless of your opinion of how I must pay for those sins. My confession surpassed the accusations against anyone innocent.

There is no plea bargain in this case. Death is the only penalty. I have been up against this in the past. Yes, I certainly deserve death. In that, you are right.

I have said here that if Mr. Ramsey wishes to come to my home and take my life, he is most welcome to do so. But you must understand that I evaded law enforcement for all those years. I don't feel that it is the only way for me to die at the hands of my enemies to suffice

for JonBenét's death. Would you be just as satisfied if I died by my own hand? Would you be satisfied if I died at the hands of an assassin? Ultimately I will most likely die. And when that time comes, will you be displeased that I did not die at the hands of law enforcement? If I am to live and die and then experience an eternity in Hell, will this not as well suffice? You see... in my eyes, I see no punishment that is harsh enough for what I took away.

## **JONBENET**

Q: You say you have met JonBenét on several occasions. When and where was the first? Were her parents present at any of the meetings?

A: To know a child, one must have a connection with an adult. I cannot divulge any information that would compromise the anonymity of those who were involved with my connection to JonBenét.

Q: There are a lot of comments about your connection being a woman. I did not perceive that at all - the person I had in mind was male.

A: I would not be set that my connection was male.

Q: How did you know of JonBenét since no one else had ever heard of her before 1996?

A: I cannot divulge the details of my connection with JonBenét so as not to compromise the anonymity of my liaison. Please consider proximity once more as it relates to my connection with her. I have known many children from all parts of the world. Some were from high profile families and some were not. For instance, I have known several other pageant girls over the years even prior to JonBenét's birth. You ask "How did you know of JonBenét since no one else had ever heard of her before 1996?" My response is that the nation does not have to be focused on a child for me to know her. She was known by several people in her life before she was known to the world due her death.

Q: Did you personally know JonBenét?

A: Yes I knew JonBenét personally. Yes, I met her on several occasions. Yes, of course she knew me also. Yes, we had conversations. She was always very pleased to see me and I her. I loved her so much and she was very aware of that. I won't speak for her feelings though I know what they were as it was quite evident.

Q: Do you ever visit JonBenét memorial sites? Are you a member on any of them?"

A: No. I regularly visit her grave.

## RANSOM NOTE

Q: The ransom note says, "We have your daughter" yet you say that you acted alone. Why put "we" then?

A: The note was diversionary.

Q: Why is the note only addressed to John Ramsey? Why not Patsy?

A: It would not have been appropriate to address the note to her mother.

Q: What is the meaning of the \$118,000.00? Why that amount?

A: Multiple meanings. One being the focus on 100,000 dollars with an amount above that. The other... an influence from the past.

Q: I don't see where you have ever claimed that you wrote the ransom note left on the stairs

at the Ramsey's the night their daughter was killed. Did you write it?

A: Yes.

Q: You had said that you "dropped" the note on the stairs when you were startled by a noise.

(I believe you said it was your intention to take it upstairs and place it on JonBenét's pillow.) When you posted this, there were a few comments about how the note seemed to be deliberately placed on the tread rather than having been "dropped". (Posters claim it was neatly spread out on the tread.)

A: Yes, I have said that I must have dropped the note on the stairs. I am sure you can look up the records of what I said to Michael Tracey. I conveyed to him that I was in such a panic that I did not know what happened to the note. It was my assumption that I dropped the note on the stairs because I do not recall having all of it with me when I made my way to access the side door. It must be understood that I was under a tremendous amount of stress. I had just lost the most precious child in my life. I was frantic to get back to her. I thought someone in the house had detected me. I was frantically trying to exit the house. The delivery of the note was interrupted and became the last of my concern. If you are asking me in what arrangement the note was dropped on the stairs, I cannot tell you that. That should be understandable under the frantic circumstances.

Q: What does SBTC mean?

A: In my manuscript I write, "For lack of a better acronym." Melissa Shotts, mother of Quientana Ray, a girl I took in the middle of the night when she was 12 and married at 13, stated that I signed off letters to her daughter at the time with the acronym SBTC. An excerpt from a

yearbook

I wrote expounded on the acronym as being "I Shall Be the Conqueror". This also correlates to the sign off "Victory" which is a word synonymous with "Conqueror". This is not what I described in my manuscript or to Michael Tracey.

Q: Did you write the note with your left hand?

A: I mentioned that in my manuscript. When asked for the slightest sample by law enforcement, I was asked to deliver it with my left hand - a magician's sleight of hand, and it worked perfectly. I am right handed.

### **12/25-26/1996**

Q: Are you responsible for JonBenét's death?

A: Yes, I am responsible for JonBenét's death.

Q: Did you have an accomplice?

A: There was not an accomplice. I was with her alone.

Q: Why did you specifically choose to kill JonBenét since she did live so far from yourself at the time? I'm sure that there are other little girls who were just as pretty or probably prettier than JonBenét close to where you live? Why travel so far?

A: I did not choose to "kill" any child. Her death was not planned nor was it intentional. To answer the final part of your question, you are not looking more closely at issues of proximity during the times I met with her prior to her death.

Q: Why did you choose XMAS day to travel to Boulder and commit this crime? Didn't you want to exchange gifts with your family at that time?

A: I discussed some of this with law enforcement. I will not divulge every detail of why I chose this time. I will tell you that I had several weeks away from school and work - time needed.

Q: What were your intentions when you went out to Boulder that faithful day?

A: To be with her.

Q: Wouldn't you agree that it is an obvious fact that when you knowingly and willingly take the time to "plan" to construct a garrote and "intentionally" put it around another person's neck to suffocate them that it cannot be considered an accident? To me this is a premeditated act isn't it?

A: The act of asphyxia in this context had nothing to do with death but instead was a sexual and

romantic act.

Q: The night you killed her, did JonBenét say anything to you?

A: We did talk to each other. Some of the words we shared are documented in my manuscript "Daxis".

Q: Why did you bring another pair of underwear, which was too big for her?

A: I did not bring them from outside the home.

Q: You say that JonBenét did not suffer in her death. The "garrote" left a deep impression in

her skin, there are red marks on her neck. How is that painless? What are those red marks and how did they get there?"

A: I will not discuss the details of why she did not suffer here on this forum.

Q: It's been said the black markings on her are from a taser, but you say you did not use one.

What are they from then?"

A: I discussed that with Michael Tracey but will not discuss that here. I can tell you emphatically

that no taser was present. It should be asked why the medical examiner made no such determinations.

Q: You said you had to return to get your shoes which you had removed (to keep from making noise as you went upstairs?).

A: Yes; however, I do not recall saying that I removed my shoes so as not to make noise. It was for

many reasons. For one, I was raised by a strict grandmother who would never allow me to wear

shoes inside especially on carpet.

Q: You also said you probably would have left via the butler's door had it not been for your having to retrieve your shoes. Therefore you left through the window, the same place you entered.

A: Yes.

Q: What were you wearing when JonBenét passed away?

A: I cannot respond to that.

Q: What did you do after leaving the Ramsey's house? Did you tell anyone what had happened? If not, how did you mentally handle it by yourself?"

A: I could not discuss it with anyone. It was a secret that was mine to bear for all those years. There

were only two exceptions that I so deeply regret. I deeply regret bringing anything up about

JonBenét with Wendy Hutchins. At the time, I thought she was potentially a child molester or child

killer herself. I was simply trying to gain her trust so that I might get closer to the truth about her. I

was not about to provide her with anything authentic and I didn't. And then, I would speak

indirectly about JonBenét to Michael Tracey which began circa 2002. I mostly evaded him but would allow myself to at least touch on the subject of JonBenét. He often said I was being elliptical. Again, I was not about to give him any information that would allow him to make the connection that I was responsible for JonBenét's death. It was not until I felt an urgency to reach out to Patricia due her impending death that I completely and fully confessed to the death of her sweet child. And for doing that, I have no regrets. That is the first time I told anyone what actually happened.

Q: What approximate time did JonBenét pass away?

A: I did not see the time precisely when she died. You must understand that I went through a very traumatic event with her. I lost track of time from the moment I discovered that she was not breathing, through a revival attempt that lasted an unknown amount of time due my hysterical state of mind and through the moments of contemplation to assure she would not be in a vegetative state, until the very end. Time became nonexistent. Though I know it is not to be considered that I experienced a trauma, it is factual that I did.

Q: Was this your first time alone in a situation such as this with JonBenét?

A: It was the first time I was alone with her with all the elements that existed as they did that night.

Q: How far in advance of JonBenét's death did you arrive in Boulder?

A: I cannot respond to that.

Q: In which room was JonBenét suspended?

A: In the basement room that I entered with the windows. I referred to it as our hideaway.

Q: Did you handle the Ramsey's dictionary?"

A: No.

Q: I know you said you did not drug JonBenét, but did you use chloroform?"

A: Absolutely not. That makes no sense.

Q: How is it there was no evidence of you being there like no fingerprints or anything? Did you wear some kind of special gloves or something?"

A: At times, yes.

Q: The stun gun theory was not brought up until after the autopsy was performed. Lou Smit

thought that the marks on the side of her face looked like burns from a stun gun, but you can't tell from just looking at a picture. The Ramseys declined to have JonBenét exhumed, so there's really no way to tell if a stun gun was used or not. If they would have exhumed her, they might have been able to tell if there had been any electrical charge in her tissue. I

think that theory makes a lot of sense; after they did that test on the pig, there were a lot of similarities.

A: That simply did not happen.

## **JOHN MARK KARR**

Q: You are pretty much telling people yourself that you are a pedophile. How do you expect people, especially parents, to react?

A: When asked if I am a pedophile, I have answered that I am not.

Q: What about the Sonoma County charges?

A: The alleged evidence in Sonoma County vanished. It must be clarified the nature of these charges. The alleged files were deleted and supposedly located on a broken computer with a hard drive that was inaccessible and had been stored under a staircase. This was confirmed by Lara Knutson in a law enforcement interview on September 1, 2006. The computer was not functional for years. The hard drive was a refurbished drive and could have contained deleted files from a past user. The alleged files involved photos that could not be determined that the subjects were under 14 years of age by age specialists hired by the prosecution. When shown the files, I had never seen them before. Law enforcement found a box containing a zip drive that contained 1,600 images. They were unable to prove that it belonged to me after checking the drive for my prints. I have never owned a zip drive. My attorney requested 100 of those images and stated that they all involved pornographic photos of little BOYS. As I have said time and again, I detest child pornography and forever will. I have never dabbled in child pornography and have strongly voiced my opinions to those who have made any comments supporting such photos.

Q: Where do you get money to live on?

A: I have no income. I live with my father. I only receive food and shelter.

Q: Have you ever been convicted of a sex crime?

A: I have never been convicted of sex crime.

Q: What size shoe do you wear?

A: I wear 8 and a half to 9 (42 to 43) depending on the manufacturer. I usually wear slippers but have also worn hiking boots and sandals.

Q: Can you explain why you were in contact with the killer of Polly Klaas.

A: I wanted to know if he loved her.

Q: Why did you move to Petaluma where Polly was killed?"

A: I would have preferred Sausalito or San Rafael. We moved in an area located between Santa

Rosa and San Francisco. Petaluma was centrally located and the most economical city located

close to my ex-wife's work and my work. Again, I would have preferred Sausalito or San Rafael.

Q: Did you ever claim that you raped a little black girl?

A: No I did not. Who are you referring to? I think I know the answer but I do not respond to vague questions.

## **CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN**

Q: Have you ever considered treatment services to help you overcome attraction to children?

A: No, however, I do not discourage treatment for those attracted to children though I think more

could be done that would prevent children from being harmed.

Q: Are you concerned that you could hurt another child, as you believe you harmed JonBenét?

A: As I believe? No, I am not concerned that I will hurt another child.

## **STATEMENTS:**

Somewhere along the way, the system that is in place now is failing our children. Kids continue to be harmed by registered sex offenders. If this is the answer to the problem, why are so many that are registered continuing to harm children? Something more must be done. We must reach those who are harming children in a way that might serve to prevent this from happening. Hate and disapproval are in place; however, it might tend to distract us from ways to deal with these individuals in a constructive manner. I propose a dialogue that will serve to provide a place where these individuals can express themselves regardless of how disturbing it might be. This will give an opportunity to communicate the alternatives and coping skills that might hopefully turn these people around and away from the thoughts of harming a child. If but one child can be saved through these efforts, it would be worth years of effort.

In my life, I have committed myself to change. This requires reconditioning my thoughts and feelings. After JonBenét's death, I made every effort to give as much as I could back to every child I worked with to atone for the ultimate sin of taking a life. I do pray quite a bit though I do not claim to be the best Christian. I do believe that one's faith can play a huge role in such a transformation.

Q: Would you be able to elaborate on reconditioning of your thoughts and feelings; what that

really looks like?

A: Reconditioning would include self control and a more appropriate way to deal with previous thoughts and feelings that, at the time, led to actions that could harm a child. There are basic coping mechanisms that can help. Communication in a trusted environment is important as well.

Q: Most people change behaviors when pain becomes too great and very often as the direct result of losses such as family, freedom or finances etc. What was the catalyst that promoted your desire to change and when did that happen?

A: It would include loss to the greatest degree. JonBenét's death was one turning point. The tremendous loss I experienced in 2006 was yet another turning point. It must be kept in mind that no one is perfect.

## **GOTHIC BOX**

Q: What is this "gothic" box and how come it was it was not mentioned when you first arrested?

A: It was mentioned by me in phone conversations with Tracey as well as in my manuscript prior to my arrest.

Q: Can you please describe the Gothic Box? How big is it? Are there any markings on it?

A: I described the box in my manuscript and in my communications with Michael Tracey and law enforcement. At this point, I do not wish to discuss it here.

## **MEDIA/INTERVIEWS**

Q: You claim to want to live a normal life. If you truly want a normal life, then why keep putting yourself out in the media?

A: I kept silent for a year. I am asked to interview. I think it is important that I talk. I have a responsibility to talk. I have a right to talk. I don't construct the questions. They always revolve around my connection with JonBenét. I simply respond.

Q: What is the fame bringing you, and I mean like how much are you paid for the interviews?

A: I dislike the term "famous". I voiced that on Larry King Live last year. I was living my life in obscurity prior to my arrest. I was hiding and running from law enforcement. I had a wonderful life teaching. I loved my life and the wonderful children around me. Why would I jeopardize my life working with children to obtain the term you refer to? Also, I have never been paid for an interview.

Q: What about that book Daxis you wrote and when is that going to be published?

A: The manuscript is not in the hands of any publisher or literary agent.

Q: How much of the movie rights are you going to get and when is it coming out?

A: I don't know what you are talking about. That does not exist.

Q: If you can answer how much you make a year basking in all this fame and how great your

my privacy, and so much more. If not for Brooke, I could easily say that I have lost everything.

that night.

## **MICHAEL TRACEY**

A: Yes, he always assured me that our conversations were strictly confidential. In so many ways, I

feel deceived however I know he was doing his civic duty.

Q: May we see the "mystery bear" photo you sent to Michael Tracy?

A: I sent a photo of a picture that resembled me as a child. I was blonde and very feminine.

I

explained to Tracey at the time that the photo was one of child actress Heather O'Rourke.

**STATEMENT:** I was truly not aware that Michael Tracey had engaged in numerous investigative pursuits. I don't think that, in any way, minimizes the seriousness of my arrest. I personally hold nothing against him.
